- 20 months in 100% new French oak
- 14.5% alcohol by volume
- 780 cases (750ml), 300 magnums (1.51)






Standing in this vineyard first planted nearly 100 years ago, watching the horses till the soil just as they have for a century, it's easy to understand this Malbec's magnificent terroir expression. Intense, fresh red and black fruits combine with linear minerality, bright acidity and silky tannins to produce a powerful, elegant and sultry seduction in a glass.



## 2010 MALBEC / SYRAH

- Sobremesa Vineyard,
  Alto Vistaflores, Uco
  Valley, Mendoza
- 2 tons / acre
- 20 months in 50% new French oak, 50% 2nd year seasoned oak
- 14.5% alcohol by volume
- 1093 cases (750ml),
  300 magnums (1.5l)



Ideally situated from 3,600 ft. above sea level in the Uco Valley, Mendoza, Sobremesa Vineyard is bathed in warm sunlight and touched by cool breezes blowing from the top reaches of the imposing Andes Mountains. Only a fraction of the highest quality grapes are carefully selected to impart the freshness of the higher altitudes. Harmoniously integrated immediately after fermentation, this commanding blend of 55% Malbec, 35% Syrah and 10% Petit Verdot boasts great power, multi-layered complexity and length.
